**Teachers' HAVEN** aims to **strengthen teacher wellbeing** and **professional growth** by developing **practical tools, research-informed training**, and a **sustainable European**

**Teachers' Academy.** The project will produce a complete training programme, an online learning platform with self-study materials, interactive resources, and specialised workshops supporting **emotional resilience, classroom management**, and **self-efficacy**. A key outcome of the project is the development of the Teachers' Academy curriculum, the Academy e-learning platform, a comprehensive wellbeing training course, national and European bootcamps, and annual Congresses bringing educators and experts together to share practices and insights.

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# Teachers' HAVEN Needs Analysis

## UNDERSTANDING WHAT EDUCATORS TRULY NEED

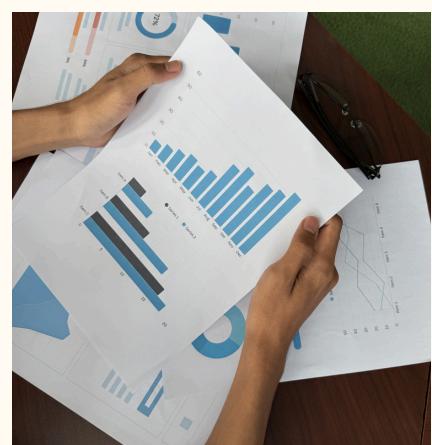
As a foundational step for the Teachers' HAVEN project, the project partners carried out a **comprehensive Needs Analysis (teachers' needs)** to better understand the pressures, expectations, and **wellbeing challenges** faced by teachers across Europe. This key outcome brings together insights from questionnaires, focus groups, and interviews with teachers, school leaders, mentors, and training providers in all partner countries. Its findings now guide the design of the Teachers' Academy and the project's **training materials**.

Across the data, a clear picture emerged: **teachers are deeply committed to their profession, yet face growing emotional and workload-related pressures**. Many participants described difficulty **balancing** instructional duties with administrative demands, classroom management challenges, and limited opportunities for psychological or professional support. Early-career teachers, in particular, reported feeling **overwhelmed** and **lacking structured mentoring** during their transition into the profession.

At the same time, the analysis highlighted **teachers' strong desire for meaningful support systems, practical wellbeing tools, and training that goes beyond traditional pedagogy**. Teachers expressed interest in **developing** emotional resilience, strengthening self-efficacy, **improving** work-life balance, and **building** healthier classroom environments. School leaders and training institutions echoed these needs, emphasising the importance of **coordinated, school-wide approaches to wellbeing**.

These findings form the **evidence base for the Teachers' HAVEN Academy**. They ensure that the project's upcoming modules and resources **directly reflect** teachers' lived experiences and **respond to the real challenges** identified during fieldwork. By grounding our future work in this robust analysis, the project moves forward with a **clear understanding** of how to **support educators** in sustainable, practical, and empowering ways.
